This exclusive event, an opportunity to hear exclusively about Hamburg's Reeperbahn Festival, is by invitation only and will be a great opportunity to meet the Reeperbahn Festival's team in London and hear directly about the life and creative talent of one of the most important artists of his generation, who just released his retrospective book "it started in Hamburg", which charts his remarkeable lifes work.

Klaus Voormann's association with the **Beatles** dates back to their time in Hamburg in the early 1960's. Voorman lived in the





Beatles London flat with George Harrison and Ringo Starr once Paul McCartney and John Lennon moved out to live with their respecitve partners and designed the cover of their album Revolver for which he won a Grammy. Following the Beatles split, rumours circulated about a new band forming consisting of John Lennon, George Harrison, Ringo Starr and Klaus Voorman.

Our event will give invited media guests unprecedented access to see Klaus Voormann up close and personal and hear about his hugely anticipated new book **'It started in Hamburg'** which charts his remarkable lifes work and his own annecdotes on the eve of the Hamburg on Tour Music Event at London's Boiler House.

Klaus Voorman is a notable music artist and producer in his own right. He can be heard as a session musician on John Lennon's iconic 'Imagine', can be heard playing on Ringo Starr's track 'I'm the greatest' and he played on albums by Lennon, Harrison and Starr. In the 1990's he designed the artwork for the Beatles Anthology albums and 2009 heralded the release of his own debut album 'A Sideman's Journey' which the two surviving Beatles appeared on as Voorman and Friends.

During 2018's globally renowned Reeperbahn Festival, a special exhibition will premier at the festival, documenting the Klaus Voormann catalogue and his award winning career.

This very special event will take place on Friday 31st August 2018 at 12.00-13.00 at Boiler House, 152 Brick Lane London.
